ENTRY FEE

Entry Fee \$35 for the first entry, \$5.00 for each additional entry up to 5. To enter, go to www.elkgrovetfineartscenter.org, click the Exhibition tab, then select Calendar of Events.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- All artwork must be original, fine-art quality work conceived and created solely by the entering artist(s), and completed within the past 2 years. Original work does not include class or workshop pieces, copies, giclée's or enhanced giclée's, or work produced by any commercial printing process (except photography). Copyrighted work and artwork previously shown in a juried EGFAC exhibition are not eligible. Submitted artwork must match the online entry exactly and be listed for sale.
- All artwork must be suitable for family viewing and may not have been previously accepted into any EGFAC competition.
- All appropriate media are accepted, provided the work is ready to hang or display. For this exhibition, hanging artwork, including the frame, may not exceed 40 x 40 inches.
- All canvas pieces must have finished painted edges. Works with gallery wrap less than 1.5 inches must be framed. All hanging pieces must be wired with D-rings only, and wire ends must be taped. Protruding nails, staples, and sawtooth hangers are not allowed. Artwork with glass must have rigid frames, and pieces larger than 29 x 35 inches must use plastic instead of glass.
- Sculptures over 50 lbs. must be installed by the artist. Installations must comply with OSHA, fire, and safety codes, and free-standing work must be stable and safe for viewing. Two-dimensional work should not exceed 40 lbs.
- Please place the following information on the back of 2D works and on the bottom or back of 3D works: artist name, address, title, size, medium, and price.
- All artwork must be offered for sale.
- EGFAC handles all exhibition sales and retains a 40% commission on each sale.
- All artwork must remain on display for the full exhibition period unless otherwise noted.
- Artists must list gallery prices in whole dollar amounts. **No price changes are allowed after art intake.**

ARTIST PAYMENTS: Net sale proceeds (sale price minus commission) will be paid by check at the end of the exhibition. Checks will be mailed to the artist address on file.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: Entries will be handled and stored with care. By submitting artwork, the artist agrees to the conditions in this prospectus and the Elk Grove Fine Arts Center Works on Consignment Agreement. The artist also consents to the use of their name and artwork images for promotional and advertising purposes by the Elk Grove Fine Arts Center. Accepted artists must sign the Works on Consignment Agreement for Art Competitions.
